The World According to Mister Rogers

(excerpts taken from "Life's Journeys According to Mister Rogers)

"I wonder if we might pledge ourselves to remember what life is really all about—not to be afraid that we're less flashy than the next, not to worry that our influences is not that of a tornado, but rather that of a grain of sand in an oyster! Do we have that kind of patience?"

"It's really easy to fall into the trap of believing that we do is more important than what we are. Of course, it's the opposite that's true: What we are ultimately determines what we do."

"I need thinking time when someone asks me a searching question. I wonder why it seems to be so uncomfortable for many people to wait through the silence. People of all ages have deep feelings, and if we have the patience to wait through the silence, it's often astounding what people will tell us."
